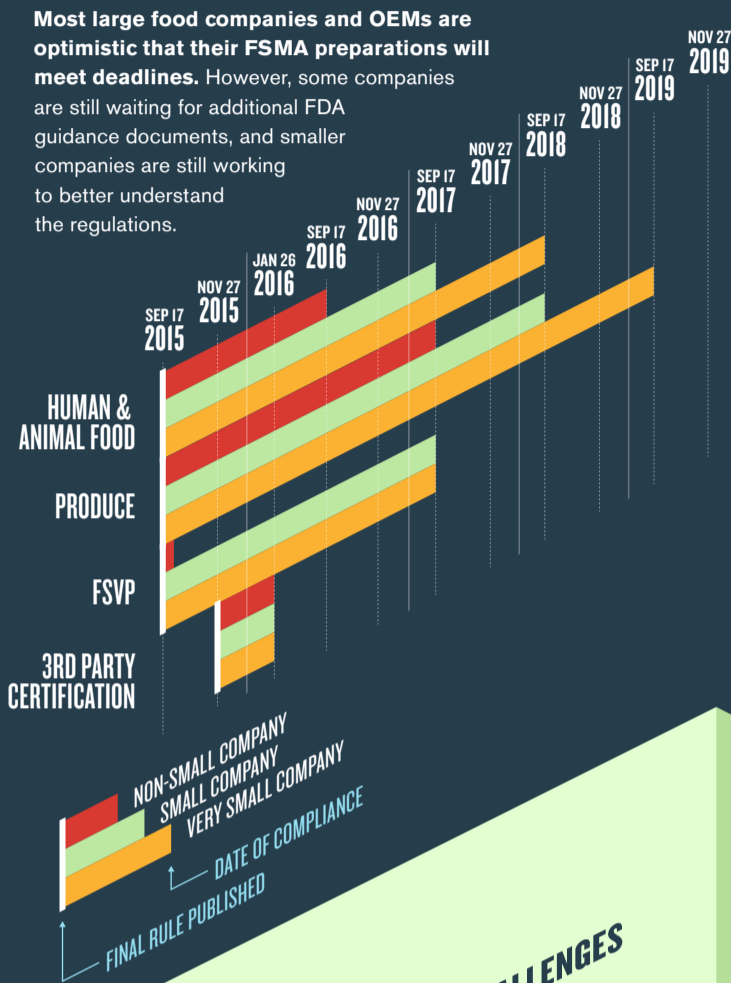

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has mostly finalized Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) regulations and has begun implementation and enforcement. In its 2016 Food Safety Modernization Act Update Report, PMMI, The Association for Packaging and Processing Technologies, compiles and analyzes responses from 47 food industry stakeholders on FSMA preparedness and what food manufacturers will need from their supplier partners.

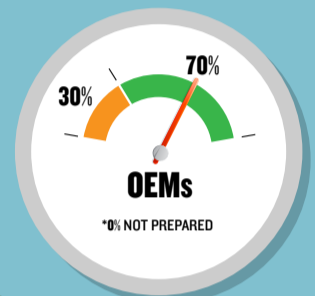
FSMA COMPLIANCE

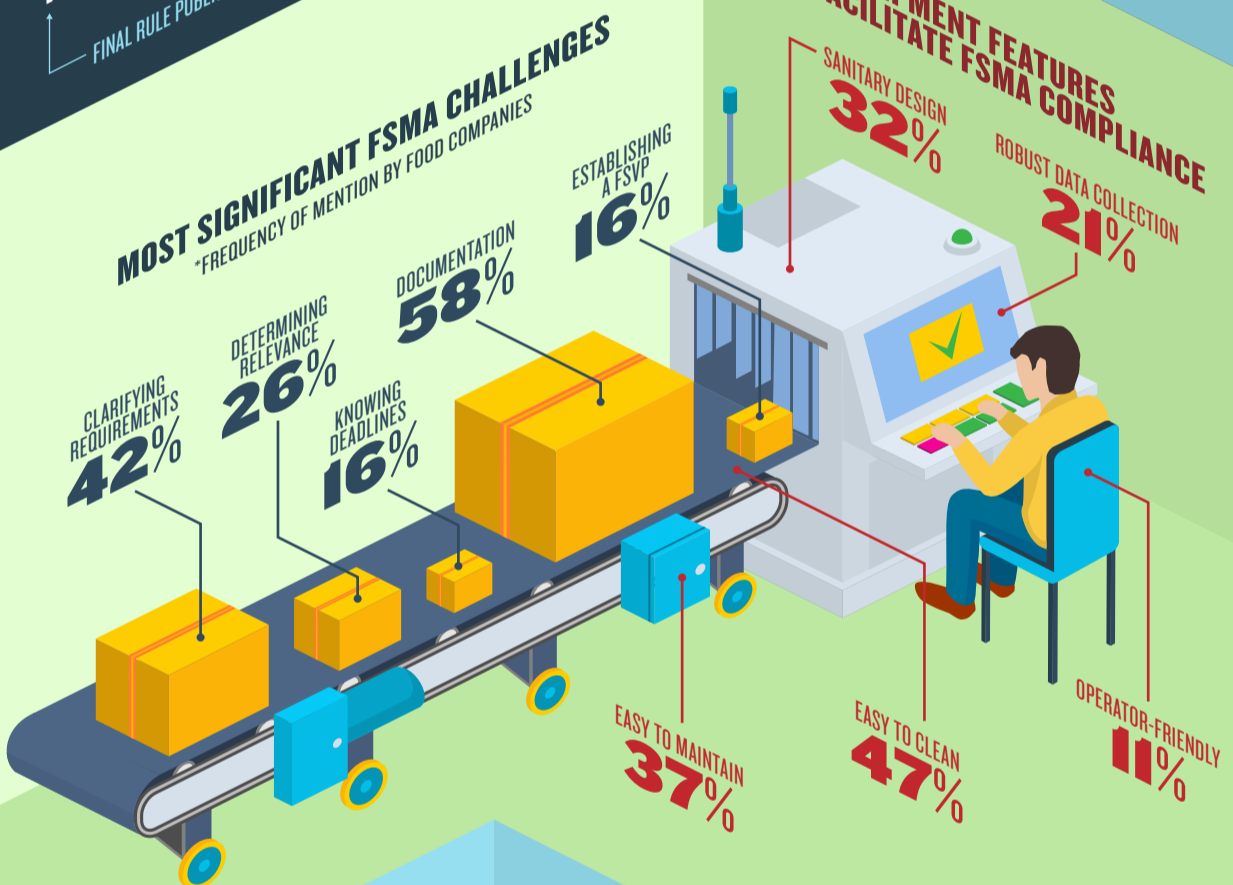
FSMA PREPAREDNESS

- EXTREMELY PREPARED

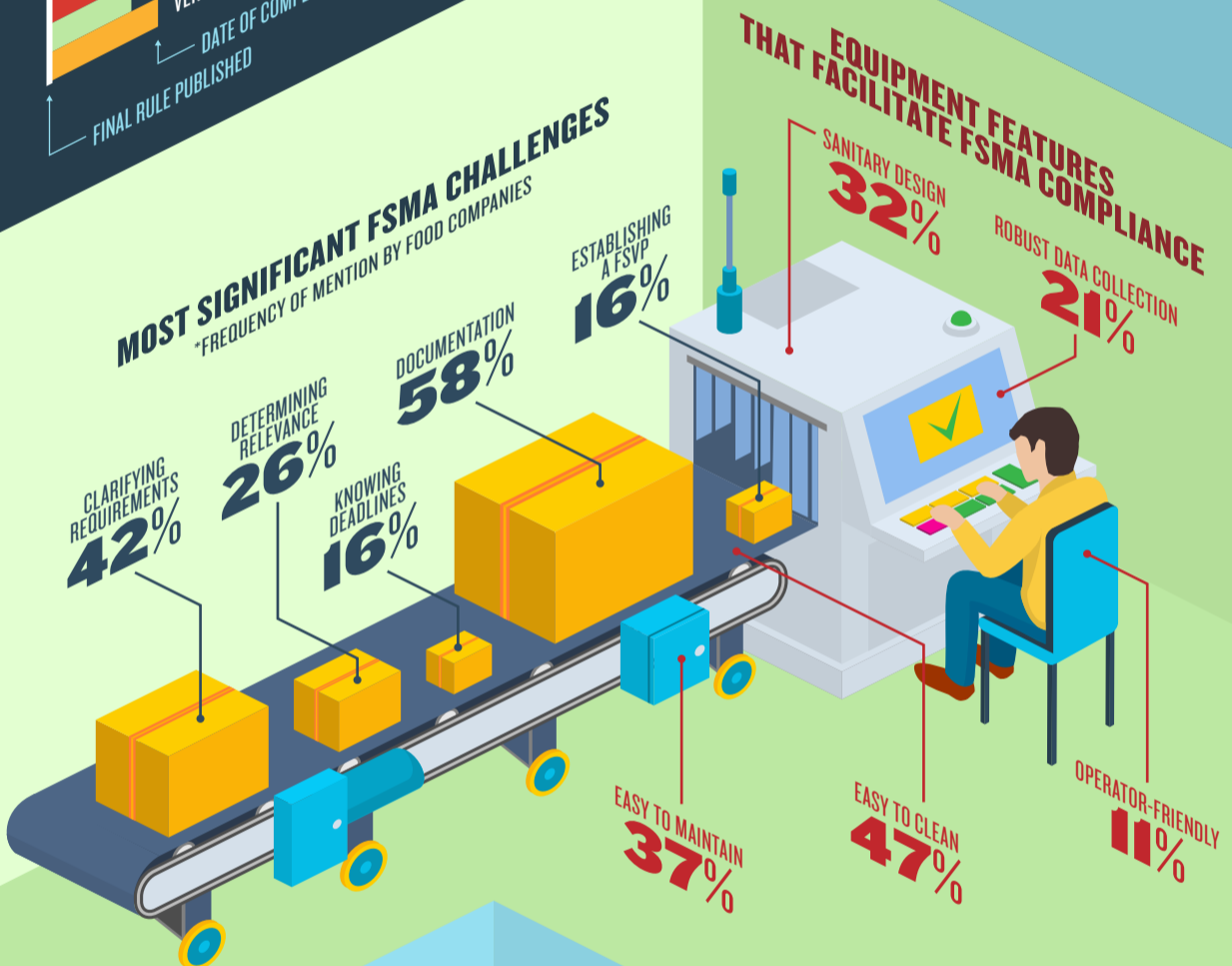


MOST SIGNIFICANT FSMA CHALLENGES
