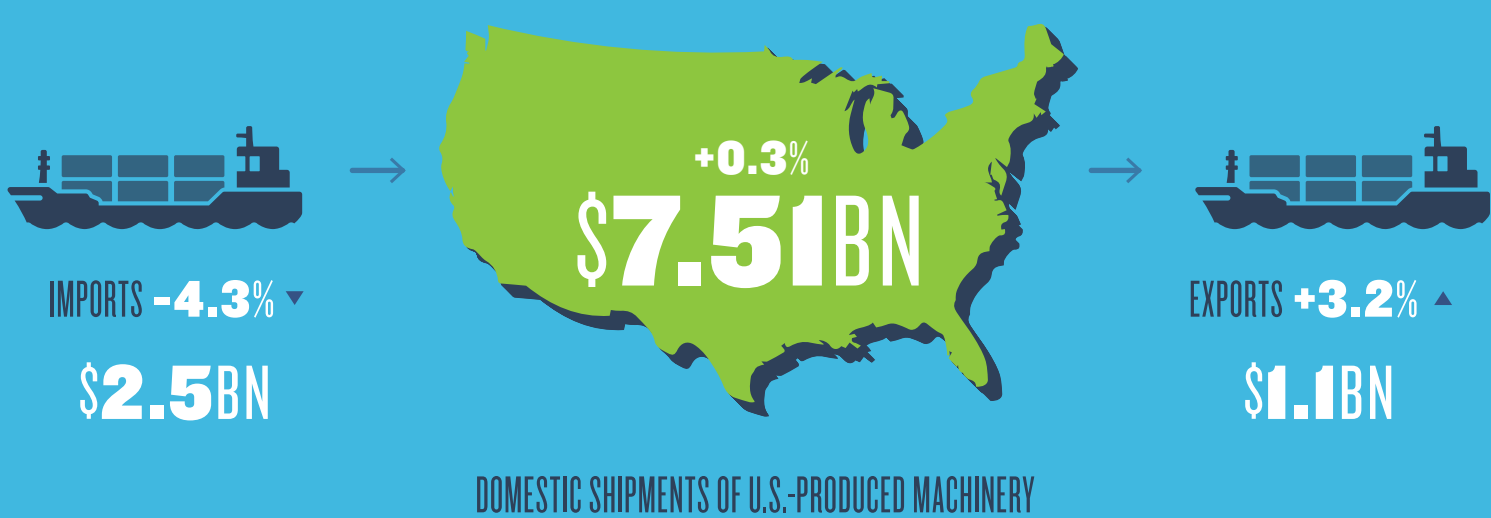


2016 PMMI STATE OF THE PACKAGING INDUSTRY—U.S. PACKAGING MACHINERY REPORT



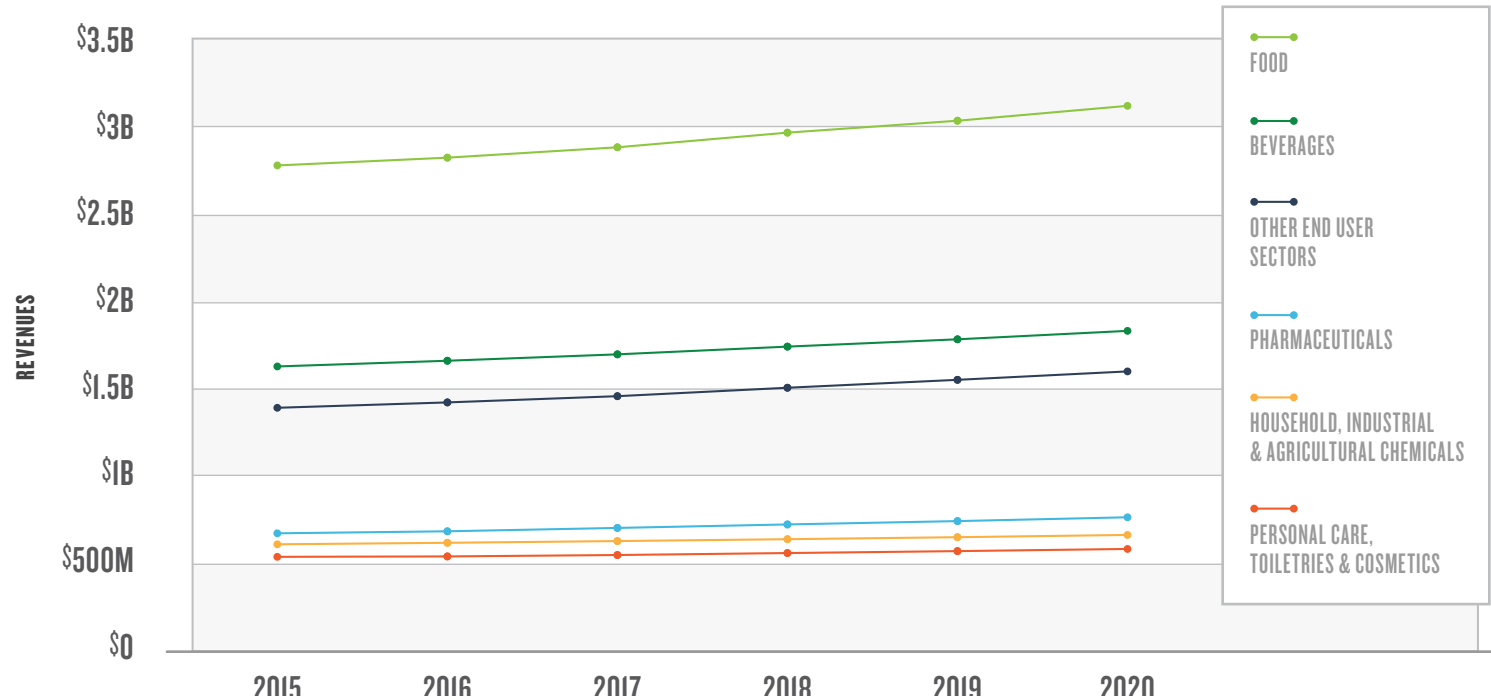
PMMI, The Association for Packaging and Processing Technologies, reported on the current state of the U.S. packaging machinery market and looked ahead to what's in store through 2020.

ESTIMATED AT \$10 BILLION AS OF 2015.



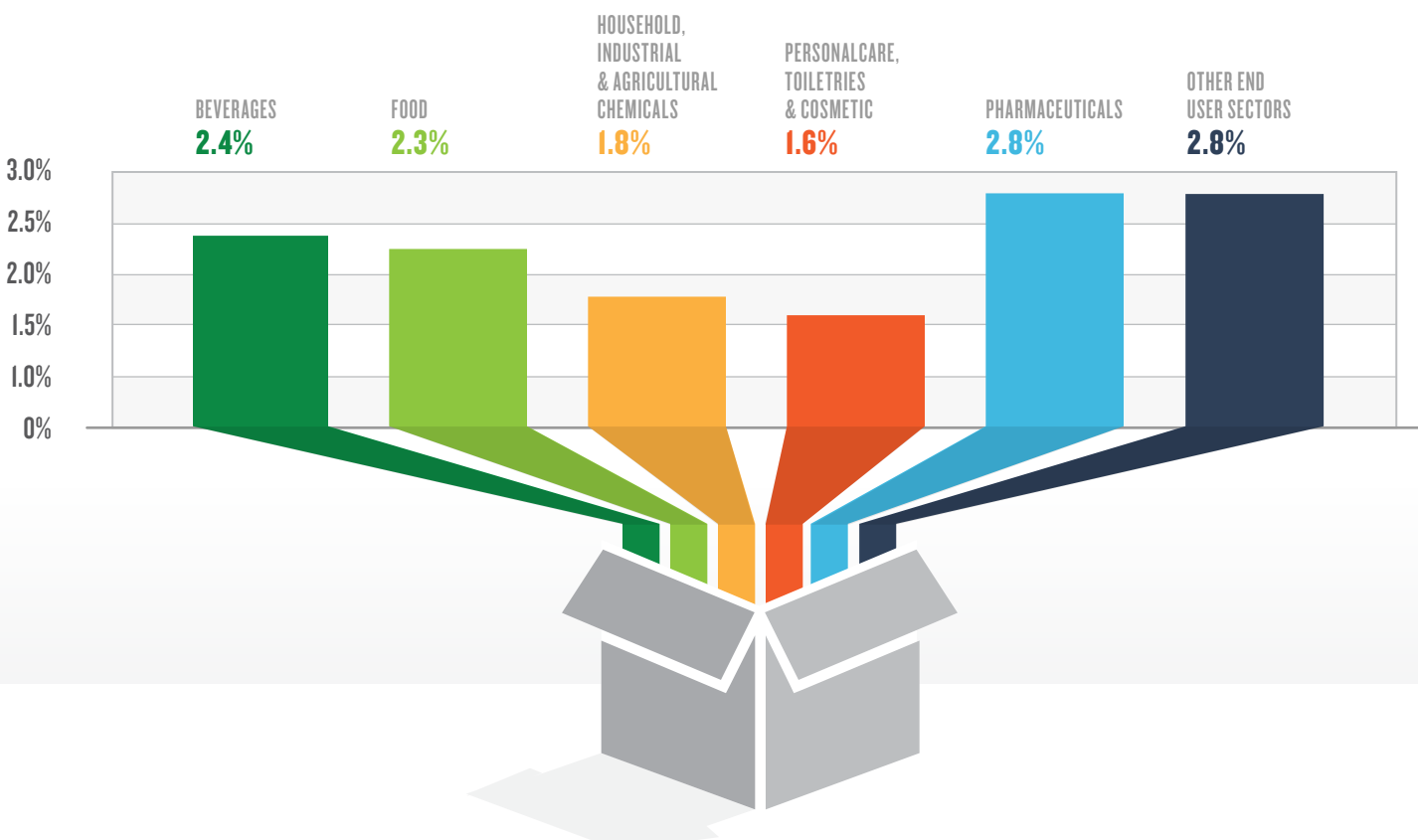
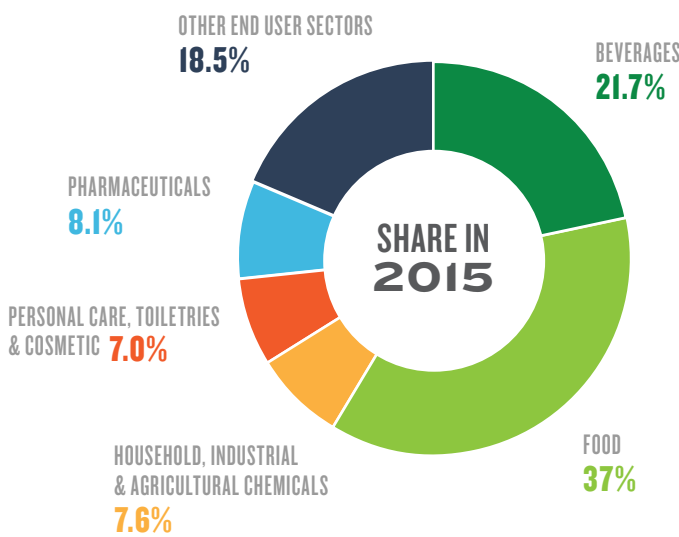

U.S. PACKAGING MACHINERY SHIPMENTS BY INDUSTRY SECTOR

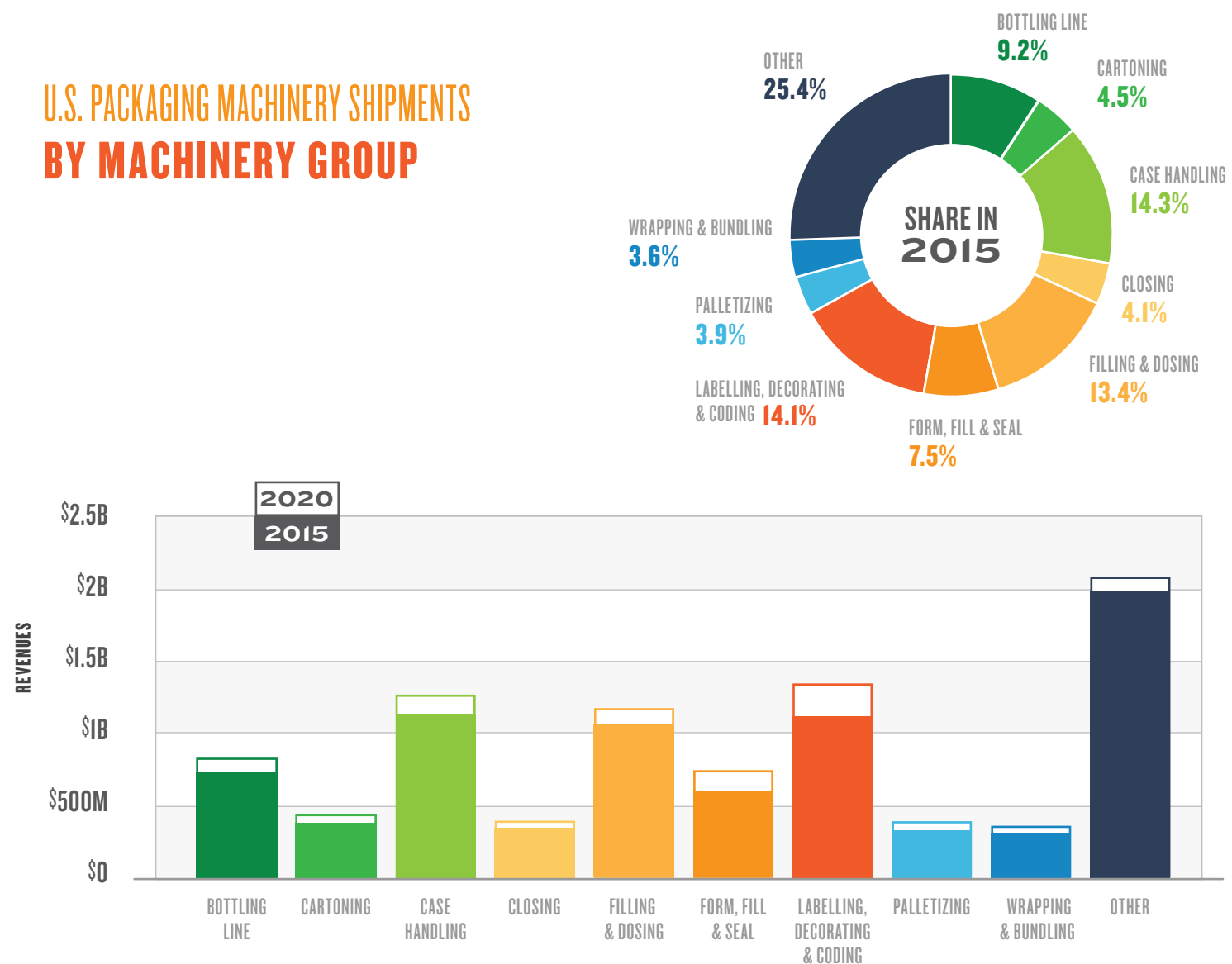


Food is the largest industry sector representing 37% of all U.S. packaging shipments, followed by the beverage industry at 21.7%.

Pharmaceuticals are tied for the fastest growing sector, with a CAGR of 2.8% through 2020, followed by the beverage industry, forecast to grow at a CAGR of 2.4%.
